Gator Nine Seeks Second Win Today

DICKINSON, March 13 — Coach Jack Porter will send his Dickinson Gators against the Houston Bellaire Cardinal nine Friday at 4 p.m. on the local field in quest of a victory over a Class AAAA team.

Bellaire's lineup is composed of boys who eliminated Dickinson in the state senior teenage meet last summer at San Angelo.

Listed Friday for mound duty is Tommy (Red) Stewart, a strong armed right-hander with a good curve and fast ball. On the receiving end behind the plate will be either Donald Kelly or Kenny Lee, the latter a two-homer hero over La Marque on Tuesday.

Rounding out the Dickinson Infield will be Bobby Anderson at the initial sack, Ronnie Clark and Eddie Hall making up the keystone combination and Frank Emmite at third. Others in the infield picture include Jean Thompson at second base and Kelly who can move in at first base or Stewart, with a good lead in runs, changing places with Emmite at third on the mound.

Reading from left to right in the outer garden finds Homer Clark, the fleetfooted Hugh Lee Simmons, his fingers healed sufficiently and Ernie Deats. This trio could easily be replaced by Dale Campbell, Eddie Weaver and Alvis Bowles who fired a good portside game against La Marque in the Gators' 7-3 win on Tuesday.

Porter and his crew are seeking their fourth straight Class B Interscholastic League Baseball championship this season having advanced in the past four years to as far as the ILB would permit for school boy champions in Class B.
