Gators Prep For Relays At Angleton

Dickinson's Gator track men are working out this week for Saturday's trip to the Angleton Relays after placing fourth in the Liberty meet last Saturday.

The Gator's fourth place finish at Liberty was one point ahead of Beaumont Forest Park as Dickinson got 62 points and Forest Park got 61.

Conroe won the meet and Liberty finished second.

Dickinson set a school record in winning the mile relay and the two mile relay team picked up the only other first place finish.

The mile relay team of Dennis Sizemore, Seldon Malin, Donn Anderson, and Joe Liggio ran the distance with a time of 3:23.2 breaking the school record of 3:29.9 set last year.

The mile relay team of Malin, Tom Allen, Vic Roy and Anderson won their event with a time of 8:26.

Dickinson's 880 yard relay team of Allen, Mike Robinson, Sizemore, and Liggio ran second behind Channelview with a time of 1:26.1. The Falcons won with a time of 1:29.4.

Roy placed fourth in the 440 yard dash with a 51.9.

Robinson, Bruce Hobby, Mark Lang, and Donnie Fields ran the 880 yard medley relay and placed fifth with a 1:41.

Gator track coach Doug Reid said the team's mile relay record places them second to El Campo in a comparison of times for the region.

Reid was especially pleased with the times his Gators are considering that last year's Liberty track under the rain had left one end of the rest in a mud
