



HOW BAND WILL GROW—The Dickinson High School Gator Band, led by Vernon Coers, band director, will be made up of an estimated 143 students next year, when the school becomes a four-year school. There are 64 students in the band now. Eleven seniors are expected to graduate, and there are 90 eighth and ninth graders now, not including new students who may move into the district and students to enter from parochial school. The school board is considering a change in the band uniforms, to make the band more modern looking in view of the fact that with the increase in enrollment the band will need many new uniforms next year anyway.
