**SAN LEON HAS HEW BUILDING
\$6,500 Recently Voted *In* Being Spent on
Three-Room Schoolhouse-Dickin-
Son High Nearly completed.**

County Superintendent J. M. Fendley reported Saturday evening that he had visited San Leon during the day and had inspected the new school building now being erected there out of the proceeds of the recent issue of schoolhouse bonds voted in that district. He says- the new building is nearly complete and will be occupied in a short time.

This district recently voted \$6,000 for school building, and out of the proceeds of this Issue a modern three-room brick school building with eight-foot basement is being erected. The school building is a credit to that community, and would be a credit to communities much larger than San Leon. Not quite the whole amount of the bond Issue is being used in the building, and the residue, will be spent for new equipment. • . . •

Mr. Fendley is much gratified at the showing made thus far in the matter of bond issues for schoolhouse purposes. Dickinson will soon occupy the new eight-room two-story brick schoolhouse; San Leon is about ready to occupy her new \$6,500 schoolhouse, and La Marque has just taken the proper steps to provide a new building adequate to her needs.
