DICKINSON HAS LEAD IN COUNTY LITERARY MEET

With a total of thirteen out of twenty-two possible first places and three second places already to its credit, Dickinson high school was leading by a safe number of points for championship in the literary events of the county interscholastic league meet. One or two contests had not yet been judged and names of all winners were not ready for publication today. League City was running second.

The major part of the meet will be staged next Friday, March 29, at the League City park. Starting with playground ball and volley ball at 8:15 o'clock, these sports will be conducted, followed by track and field events. The total number of entrants is expected to run over fifty.

Friday's meet will be an all-day affair and on-lookers are requested to bring basket lunches to make of it a picnic outing. For those not bringing lunches there will be concessions on the grounds. R. K. Williams, superintendent of the Santa Fe schools, is director of athletics for the county.

The meet will close with tennis matches in Galveston Saturday, starting at 8:45 o'clock.

Officials commend those contestants who have participated for their good sportsmanship, and state this spirit has been improving during the past three years. Judges in all contests were disinterestedly out-of-county persons.
