

Dickinson Plans Dedication of School Friday

Dickinson, Tex., Sept. 28.—The \$300,000 new Dickinson High School will be formally dedicated Friday, Oct. 4, with Dr. L. A. Woods, state superintendent of public instruction, as the dedicatory speaker.

The dedicatory exercises will get under way at 5 o'clock in the afternoon, when an open house will be held. Members of the PTA hospitality committee will escort visitors over the buildings from that time until 8 o'clock at night.

At 8 o'clock the dedicatory program proper will be held in the handsome new auditorium. The program for the evening has been announced as follows:

Number by Dickinson High School Band; pledge to the flag, led by a member of the senior class; invocation, Rev. Stewart O'Dell, pastor of First Methodist Church; violin solo, Chester Parks, bandmaster; dedicatory talk, Supt. E. Martin Bolcher; presentation of principals of high school and elementary school; number by school band; presentation of school board members; principal dedicatory address, Dr. Woods; presentation of all platform guests; song, "God Bless America," by assembly, and benediction, Rev. W. L. Evans, pastor First Baptist Church.

Besides Supt. Bolcher, Dr. Woods, principals and school board members, others expected on the platform include Mrs. Kathleen Bradford Benson, county superintendent of schools; members of the county board of education; county officials; Miss Edgar Ellen Wilson, deputy state supervisor of schools, and Mrs. A. D. Mathis, county supervisor of elementary education.
