

True Cross Tells School Requirements

DICKINSON — True Cross school will begin the Fall Semester August 23rd.

Registration will take place for all students "K" through Grade 8 from 9 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. and from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. August 17 and August 18 from 9 a.m. until 12 Noon.

For the school term 1971-1972, True Cross will operate on a nine and a half months basis. Fees and tuition will be payable registration day.

Laws passed the last session of the Legislature deal with compulsory immunization for school children for six diseases - diphtheria, tetanus, poliomyelitis, measles, rubella and small pox.

In addition, True Cross School also requires that Kindergarten and first grade children, and all children entering the seventh grade, present evidence that they have had a skin tuberculin test with a negative reading.

For students entering our school for the first time, the school is requiring immunizations for polio, diphtheria, tetanus (Pertussis should not be given past the age of 6 years). Measles, rubella (not required past age of 12 years) and small pox (one vaccination within the past 10 years).

Immunizations should be completed by August 23.
