

New Stadium Proposed

DICKINSON—Charles O. Mills, chairman of the stadium committee, one of five citizens' committees studying facility needs for the Dickinson Independent School District, presented the committee's recommendations to the school board at its regular meeting last Thursday night. The stadium committee's recommendations include the construction of a new stadium with a seating capacity of 8,000 with adequate paved parking space, concession and rest room facilities on each side, proper drainage, hard surface walks, ticket booths and adequate lighting, and an all weather track to be constructed outside the stadium area. Other members of the committee were Roy Menotti, Bob Agnew, Glen Walker, and E. A. Beuclear.

Funds earmarked in the 1968 bond issue for stadium renovations were utilized on a priority basis for the construction of additional classrooms at the Dickinson Pri-

mary School and additional classrooms and a new cafeteria at Bacliff.

A new field house, the main playing football field with a sprinkling system and three practice fields were constructed, however, with funds from the last bond issue.
