RESOLUTION

WHEREAS Kenneth E. Little has served as a member of the Dickinson Independent School District Board of Trustees for thirty years having first been elected to the Board in April, 1958; and

WHEREAS during those thirty years, he has served as President of the Board for fifteen years and served as Secretary of the Board for four years; and

WHEREAS during the period from the 1957-58 school year to the 1987-88 school year, the student enrollment in the District has increased from 1,909 to 5,139; the budget has increased from \$728,761 to \$18,800,000; and the number of employees has increased from approximately 150 to 660; and

WHEREAS during Mr. Little's terms on the Board of Trustees, the Board passed five bond elections which totaled \$26,600,000 and resulted in the construction of four new schools, additions to Dickinson High School, McAdams, Primary, Dunbar, and Little schools, renovation of schools, and the replacement of roofs and mechanical systems; and

WHEREAS in his honor on July 17, 1978, in response to a petition signed by one hundred fifty-nine taxpayers from the San Leon/Bacliff area, the Board of Trustees unanimously changed the name of the Bacliff Elementary School to the Kenneth E. Little Elementary School; and

WHEREAS Mr. Little will long be remembered for his extraordinary commitment to exceptional quality educational programming; his profound sense of equilibrium as he deliberated issues affecting students, patrons, and employees; his selfless commitment of personal time and energy for the betterment of the Dickinson Independent School District; and his warm and friendly personal style; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that an expression of appreciation be hereby extended by the Board of Trustees of the Dickinson Independent School District for the invaluable and loyal service, leadership, and commitment to students, teachers, patrons, and the educational profession by Mr. Kenneth E. Little and that a certificate of merit signed by the Superintendent of Schools and the members of the Board of Trustees be presented to him.
