

# Dickinson Works For Last Game In Crosby Friday

Dickinson, Tex., Nov. 20.—Coach Moose Moller's Dickinson Gators went through brisk Monday workouts here today as they began the week's preparation for their last game of the season—a District 20B conference battle in Crosby Friday night at 7:30 o'clock.

The Gators will be looking for their second district win when they tangle with the Crosby club, their first win was over Anahuac, 8-0. At present Cedar Bayou leads the district with an undefeated conference record which lacks only this week's game with Barbers Hill to be completed.

Crosby will outweigh Dickinson in the front ranks, but it has a light, shifty backfield that has plenty of speed, Moller reported today.

Of the Dickinson players going into the game Friday, men will be lost next year from every position with the exception of end and tackle spots, Moller said today.

Returning ends will be Theodore Hillman, Leroy Russell and Edward Dixon, while those tackles who will see more service are J. L. Russell, Wade Spooner, Virgil Waters, Albert Holman and Charles Garner. Only two Gator backfield men will report next fall, Moller said—Glen Brown and Johnny Malorka.

Veterans who will go into their last high school game against Crosby are Shelton, Richards, Holley, Benoit, March, Giacchino, Harris and Sommer.
