

DICKINSON SEEKS FOURTH IN ROW

Dickinson, Tex., Dec. 19.—Coach Moose Moller's Dickinson Gators, their first three games of the season neatly marked down in the win column, move in on Coach Jack Rhodes' Webster Wildcats in Webster Wednesday night at 7 o'clock in search of their fourth straight cage victory.

Two games are carded with the B teams opening the program followed by the A squad set to.

Five lettermen will compose the starting lineup that Moller is expected to send against the Wildcats. They are Helmut Sommer, center; Pate Beneritto and Daurice Marsh, guards; and Tony Giacchino and Johnny Matorka, forwards. Richards, a squadman from last year, is also expected to see plenty of action.

Thus far the Gators have defeated Trinity Lutheran of Houston, 36-27, the ex-students of Dickinson, 42-11, and Santa Fe, 43-40.

Webster, which has been playing several weeks, has split its wins and losses about equally, having won from Pearland, Friendswood among others and having lost to such teams as Texas City and League City.

Approximately 30 players are on the squad.
