

Dickinson Gators Scrap Saratoga

Dickinson, Tex., Nov. 2.—Dickinson's Alligators will go into their district 23-B conference game with Saratoga Friday afternoon at 3 o'clock in Saratoga with a team badly hit by injuries and influenza.

Gator Coach Moose Miller declared tonight.

Greatest loss to the Gators is possibly that of Helmut Sommer, regular back, who sustained a back injury in the game with La Marque last week and will be forced to watch the Saratoga scrap from the sidelines.

Other starters whom Miller said were likely not to see service include Captain Bernard Holly, Glenn Brown, Wade Spooner and Conde Benoist—all caught by either influenza or colds. Most of these, Miller said, have been unable to practice throughout the past week, limiting drill sessions to workouts of the Gator second string.

Almost equal by comparison of games, both Saratoga and Dickinson played with Anahuac—each won over Anahuac by a single touchdown margin—the Gators are considered the under dogs on the basis of another team both have played—La Marque. Last week the

Gators went down 28-6 before the La Marque onslaught, while Saratoga defeated the latter 26-0 early in the season.

Three games in addition to the Saratoga tilt remain on the Dickinson slate—all three to be played away from home. The Gators meet Sour Lake on Nov. 10, Cedar Bayou on Nov. 18 and Crosby on Nov. 24—all conference tilts.

Due to the uncertain status of his squad, Miller could not release a definite starting lineup for the Saratoga game. The tentative starters he gave follow:

Benoist, center; J. L. Russell, left guard, and Richards, right guard; Waters, left tackle, and Garner, right tackle; Dixon, left end, and Hillman, right end; Marsh, quarterback; Shelton, left half, and Giacchio, right half, and Maiorka, fullback.
