

Dickinson Gators At Sour Lake

Dickinson, Tex., Nov. 9.—Dickinson's Gators will go into their district 28 B tilt in Sour Lake Friday afternoon at 3:30 o'clock in better shape than the same crew which was stomped by Saratoga, 27-0, last week-end, Coach Moose Moller declared today.

Most of the injuries which crippled the Gators before their meeting with Saratoga are back in the traces and apparently ready to scrap Sour Lake to a finish for third place in the district standings.

Helmut Sommer, star Gator back who was injured in the Dickinson-La. Marque fray two weeks ago, is still out with a back injury, however, and it is likely his absence will be felt keenly against Sour Lake.

A minor influenza epidemic last week which prevented the Moller charges from holding regular workouts has passed. Together with the recovery of Johnny (Red) Malroka and Wade Spooner who were injured in last week's game, the return of the regulars to the game decidedly lifted the Gators' chances for another conference win, their first since they defeated Anahuac three weeks ago.

Two conference games remain on the Gator card following their battle with Sour Lake—Cedar Bayou on Nov. 18 and Crosby Nov. 25, both games to be played away from home.

Probable Dickinson starting lineup will be: Benoist, center; Holley, left guard; Richards, right guard; J. L. Russell, left tackle; Garner, right tackle; L. Russell, left end; Hillman, right end; Browne, quarterback; Giacchino, right half; Shelton, left half, and Malroka, fullback.
