

Dickinson Gators Oppose Anahuac

Dickinson, Tex., Oct. 19.—Coach Moose Moller's Dickinson Gators run into an almost unknown quantity in the form of Anahuac high school Friday afternoon at 3:30 o'clock on the Texas City gridiron in a game that counts in the district 29-B conference scorebooks.

Anahuac, hailing from the northern part of the district of which Dickinson is a member, has dropped one tilt thus far this season, a 7-0 defeat to Saratoga, touted strong man of the district.

The Gators have won only one game this year. They felled Texas City B squad by an 18-0 count in nonconference competition, but have lost to class A Webster and to Kinkaid of Houston and Barbours Hill, the latter a conference skirmish.

Nonetheless, the Gators are in good physical condition and ready to go, Coach Moller declared tonight. With the exception of boils and a few minor infections, none of the team is on the sick list. Neither, however, will keep the first string from seeing action, he said.

Lacking in veterans, due to the fact that Dickinson is participating in Interscholastic League football for the second year, the Gators have plenty of scrap, the thing Moller is counting on to bring them through against Anahuac.

Starting for Dickinson will be: Bendist, center; Holley, left guard; Richards, right guard; J. L. Russell, left tackle; Garner, right tackle; L. Russell, left end; Hillman, right end; Browne, quarterback; Giacchino, right half; Somner, left half, and Miroka, full-back.
