Dickinson Gators Play Host to Santa Fe Tonight

DICKINSON, Oct. 14—Coach Guy Nunnally's Dickinson Gators play host to the Santa Fe Indians in a nondistrict game 8 p. m. Friday.

Fresh from a district win over Cedar Bayou, the Gators will be heavily favored to remain in the win column in the Indian tilt. Although the Indians under Coach Byrl Clayton, have improved over last year's team that the Gators swamped 57-0, they are no match for the stronger Dickinson boys.

Dickinson has two victories and three defeats for the season. Santa Fe lost to Humble and Crosby and tied Needville in their three games.
