their own territory. This time, it was Thompson with a home-run pass to Right End Sexton, the play carrying for 70 yards and a touch-down. Thompson missed the point and the Mustangs went into intermisation with a 13-0 lead.

In the second half, it was mostly the Dickinson Gators. The Gators took the ball early in the third period, and with a series of rushing plays, carried from their own 60-yard line across the Aidine goal strips. Charley Griffith shared heavy ball carrying duties with Dan Battistoni in the drive, Querterback Charley While passed to Battistoni from 5 yards out and the touchdown. A White to Willie Walker pass for the axtra point was no good.

An indication of the closeness of the game was evidenced in atsitatics.
