Alvin, Webster Are Co-Champs in District 25-A

Alvin's Yellow Jackets trampled the Dickinson Gators 40-0 at Dickinson Friday night to clinch a tie for the district 25-A football championship. They share the top with the Webster Wildcats who ran over the Aldine Mustangs 20-7 in another district clash at Webster.

The Yellow Jackets will represent the district in the state playoffs because of a previous win over the Webster team.

Both teams won six and lost one in district play this season. Alvin lost to Aldine 13-7 last week, and Webster was beaten by Alvin 12-0 early in the season.

La Marque's Tigers won over the Cleveland Indians, 19-7, in another district clash in Cleveland Friday night.

Bill Potello scored first for the Webster Wildcats on a 22 yard run in the first quarter. In the fourth quarter the Cats added what proved to be the winning touchdown. Ronny Cox went over from the one for the touchdown. Alex Dolney went over for the final Cat touchdown.
