# Gators Lose To Indians

DICKINSON, Sept. 14—The Port Acres Indians scored in the second and third periods to defeat the Dickinson Gators, 12-0, in a school-boy football game played here Friday night.

Chatlain and McFarland plunged over the touchdowns for the visitors.

Dickinson threatened in the third period. The Gators drove 60 yards to the Port Acres 12, only to lose the ball on a fumble.

The Gators outplayed Port Acres in every department except scoring, picking up 13 first downs to eight and gaining 134 yards in the air to 42 for Port Acres.

Bobby Hughes was a standout for the Gators in running. Wayne Crowson did some fine passing to

end Preston Bullard. The Gators completed 10 of 22 passes attempted.
