With less than a minute remaining in the first half the Webster team came back to tie up the game. A fourth-down pass from Tommy Jamison to Arthur Landriault was good for the score after a 25-yard run by Joe Barba gave Webster the ball on the Gators' five-yard line.

The Wildcats scored the winning touchdown in the third period when Don Williamson plunged over from the one-yard line to climax a 63-yard drive highlighted by a 33-yard run by Donald Combs.
