

Gators, Needville In District Game

DICKINSON, Oct. 30—If the Dickinson Gators intend to keep their perfect record intact in district 26-A play, they must do some real scoring in their Friday night encounter with Needville's Blue Jays.

Dickinson, in taking their last two starts in conference play, has looked like a giant killer in downing Sweeney and Santa Fe on successive weekends to remain undefeated in district competition. Meanwhile, the Blue Jays in dropping losses to favorites Missouri City and Deer Park, have shown a good offense in rolling up 27 points against such foes.

In traveling into the Blue Jay nest on Friday, the Dickinson offense will open with Bobby Koster and Leon Thomas at ends, Billy Devall and Byron Holley at tackles, Red Stewart and Dale Myers at guards, and Charles Juneman at center. Bob Doty will be the man under with halves

The offensive lineup also includes Tommy Machen in the quarterback role. Machen gives the Gators two stalwart passers, not including the rest of Coach Guy Nunnely's backfield. Against Santa Fe, the Gators used four passers in netting four touchdowns.
