Tigers Card Scrimmage With Gators

LA MARQUE, Aug. 28 — The La Marque Tigers wound up a week's practice here today and pointed to their first scrimmage which is due Tuesday night against the Dickinson Gators.

Coach Orville Etherdge announced the scrimmage for 7:30 p.m. Tuesday at La Marque and said he hoped to have the team polished enough by game time.

The Tigers will continue to use the split-T attack which has netted them two straight district titles. Gary James will be the man-under-pleting what he says will probably be his starting backfield for the Tuesday scrimmage will be Carl Lee Wylie at left half, Fred Walter at right half and Eugene Plasek at fullback.

Arnold Wimberly will be in as defensive halfback and end Bobby Smith will pull out to a halfback post when the Tigers are on the defensive. Wylie and Plasek will complete the defensive backfield.

Etherdge will still be experimenting with his forward wall but expects to have Charles Batton and Billy (Chug) Chamberlin in at tackle and guard, respectively. The other line posts will probably be switched around as he searches for a good defensive combination, Etherdge said.
