Win, 13-6

DICKINSON, Oct. 22 — Dickinson's Gators were well-named here Friday night as they wallowed to a 13-6 victory over Santa Fe.

The stout Gator line with such stalwarts as Bobby Biehl, Allan Neihl and Jackie Stewart standing out, was the deciding factor in the game.

There was no scoring in the first half but most of the action was in the Santa Fe end of the field.

The Gators went inside the Santa Fe 20 twice but couldn't push across.

Dickinson blocked three Santa Fe kicks.

In the third quarter, Stewart blocked a punt off the toe of J. W. Garrison and the ball rolled out at the Dickinson 47. Manual Martinez went to the Santa Fe 35. Hershel Hughes then sloshed 35 yards for a touchdown. Jerry Mitchner ran for the extra point.

Jimmy LeFever returned the kickoff for Santa Fe to the Dickinson 22. Then Le Fever shook loose for a tally but the extra point was blocked.

Biehl blocked a punt late in the third period and John Tidwell raced to the 42. Jerry Mitchner carried to the 16 and Mitchner finally rammed over from the one for the touchdown early in the fourth quarter. The extra point was no good.

It rained constantly during the ball game.
