

Hughes and Jerry Mitchner scored a pair of touchdowns each as the Dickinson Gators galloped to a 38-6 victory over East Bernard here Friday night.

Dickinson scored a touchdown in the second period, and the game was a close one until the fourth quarter when the Gators broke loose for 31 points.

The Gators drove 48 yards in the second period to tally a touchdown. Mitchner climaxed the drive by going over right guard for the final eight yards. David Brown added the conversion, and when halftime rolled around the Gators were out front, 7-0.

that John Brown and Hughes alternated at carrying and worked the ball deep into East Bernard territory. Two plays deep in the final stanza, Mitchner knifed over from the eight.

Brown converted, but an offside penalty rubbed out the point. The Gators, however, were not to be de-

nied, for they passed for the extra point—Hughes to Leon Thomas—to up the score to 14-0.

Minutes later Albert Titman intercepted an East Bernard pass on the 50 and returned to the 35. On the next play Hughes traveled the remaining yardage to score. Brown's kick was wide.

A recovered fumble set up the next Dickinson drive. Hughes climaxed it by going around end for the final 36 yards and a touchdown. Again Brown's kick for the point was wide.

Dickinson got off an onside kick-off and the Gators recovered the ball on the East Bernard 38. Two Williams for the touchdown. The plays later Hughes passed to Wayne pass play covered 27 yards.

Brown's kick for the point was blocked.

Dickinson kicked off and Adolph Rochunek took the boot behind his goal. He returned to the East Bernard nine. On the following play Mark Scotka unreeled the longest run of the night when he galloped 91 yards for a touchdown.

Dickinson's final touchdown came just before the game ended. Mitchner returned the ball from the Dickinson 26 to the East Bernard 46. Two plays later Williams completed a 34-yard pass play to Allen Nelhl on the two. On the following play Manuel Martinez went over.
