

NEW DICKINSON FOOTBALL COACH NAMED BY BOARD

A Contract to Larry Jack Mildren as physical education and health teacher and head football coach for Dickinson High School was approved Monday night by the Dickinson School Board.

Coach Mildren attended Tulsa University and participated in athletics from 1940 to 1943. During the war he was assigned to the Army Specialized Training School at Texas A and I in Kingsville, where he participated in all phases of athletics in the army program.

He was first employed in 1947-48 as assistant football coach and head basketball coach at Brawnsville Junior College. From 1948 to 1951 he served as assistant football coach and head basketball coach at Kingsville High School. In 1951 he moved to Arlington High School as assistant football coach. The Arlington team won the state AA championship that year. From 1952 to 1955 he was athletic director and head football coach at Pine Tree High School, an AA team in Greggton. At present he is employed as athletic director and head football coach at Ajo High School in Arizona. Ajo has over 600 high school students.

Mr. Mildren is 31 years of age, is married and has two children.
