

Dickinson Tears Jinx Apart, 13-7

Dickinson, Sept. 19. — Dickinson's Gators ripped a four-year jinx apart Friday night as they stopped Webster, 13 to 7.

Some 1700 fans at Gator Stadium saw Dickinson score in the first and third quarters to win the first game from their neighbors since 1947.

After a see-saw battle for the better part of the first quarter,

the Gators took over on their own 40 after a Webster punt went out of bounds there. A senior fullback, Andrew Wages, playing his first game, got things rolling when he circled end. Halfback Bobby Hughes, another Dickinson dynamo, pushed to the 45, and Wages got another yard. Then Quarterback Bob Doty tossed a 14-yard aerial to Hughes who went all the way. Tommy Machen's conversion made it 7 to 0, Dickinson.

Dickinson took the kick-off starting the second half and rolled 58 yards in eight plays to score their final touchdown with Halfback Billie Anderson plunging over from the 1-foot line. Machen's attempted conversion was wide and the score stood at 13 to 0 in favor of Dickinson.

Early in the final quarter, Webster got its lone score. The Wildcats had blocked a Dickinson punt which Emory Combs recovered on the Gator 20. On their third play, Joe Barba took a handoff from Robert Galloway, slashed off tackle and went 17 yards for the score. Galloway's conversion ended the scoring with Dickinson on top, 13 to 7.

Standouts for the Gators were Anderson, a 137-pounder who played fine ball both offensively and defensively; Wages, Hughes and Koster. For Webster, Don and Emory Combs, Galloway, Joe Barba and Jimmy Goodman looked good.
