

Zwahr Runs, Passes Bluejays Over Dickinson Gators, 19-0

DICKINSON, Oct. 28 — Quarterback Jimmy Zwahr ran and passed the Needville Bluejays to a 19-0 victory over the Dickinson Gators here Friday night in a district 26A schoolboy football game.

The victory keeps Needville in the driver's seat in the hectic 26A campaign.

Needville and Deer Park are tied for top place, but Needville holds the edge over Deer Park on penetrations. Last week Needville and Deer Park tied, 20-20, but the Jays had the most penetrations.

Zwahr set up all three touchdowns with his brilliant passes. He personally tallied a pair of

touchdowns and then pitched a pass for the other six-point. He added Needville's only extra point of the night.

The underdog Gators stopped the Needville running game for most of the opening period. It was toward the close of the opening quarter that Hershal Hughes fumbled and Harold Heldeman recovered the ball for Needville on the Dickinson 40. It took the Bluejays four plays to strike into paydirt.

The big gainer in the drive was a nifty 38-yard pass play from Zwahr to Victor Acebo. Zwahr climaxed the drive by plunging over from the two-yard line. Zwahr attempted to pass to Acebo for the extra point, but Hughes broke through to break up the play.

The Bluejays scored next with four minutes left on the clock in the second quarter.

Dickinson's Lloyd Hughes punted out on the Needville 36. On the first play Zwahr ran to the Dickin-

son 37. Then Zwahr connected on five straight passes—four to Terrence Kettler and one to Wayne Meyer—to move the platoon to the Dickinson 10. A roughing penalty against Dickinson moved the Jays to the Gator one, from which point Zwahr crashed over. Zwahr attempted to kick the extra point, but the ball was to one side of the uprights.

Eugene Englehardt recovered a fumble on the Dickinson 18 to set up the next Needville score. Three Zwahr passes fell incomplete. Then on a fourth down try, Zwahr hit Acebo in the end zone for a touchdown. Zwahr converted to make the final count 19-0.

The gun ending the game stopped Needville from scoring in the fourth period. The Bluejays moved to the Gator one just as the game ended.
