

Gators Finish Strong To Beat Humble in 34-12 Game

DICKINSON, Sept. 6 — Dickinson's Gators struck for a 14-6 lead at halftime and came back for three fourth quarter touchdowns to whip the Humble Wildcats, 34-12 here Saturday night. The game was postponed from Friday night because of bad weather.

The Gators rolled to 232 yards on the ground in taking their opener of the season. Humble managed only 77 yards in an attack which never could seem to get started.

Dickinson scored early in the first period when halfback Hugh Lee Simmons recovered a fumble on the Humble 20. Quarterback Eddie Hall went to the 14 on a keeper and then passed to halfback Kenneth Lee for the score. A run for the extra two points failed.

Midway in the second period the Gators scored again.

Hall returned a Humble punt to the Wildcat 30 and then carried around eight end to the eight on a keeper. Lee went to the four on a third try and then scored on his next attempt. Simmons ran over the two points.

Humble got its first score just before the half. They took a first down on the Dickinson 24. Halfback Dennis Brown, who carried the brunt of the offensive load for Humble, went to the Gator 15. Then quarterback Larry Snelling passed to end Roy Smith for the score. The pass for extra points failed.

No scoring took place in the third period as both teams moved the ball up and down the field.

In the fourth the Gators took over on their own 30. Lee then ran 70 yards for a touchdown but the play was called back by a penalty. The Gators worked the ball down to the Humble 30. Robert Topfer carried to the 24 and Simmons went to the 10. Simmons then carried over a little later from the five and also ran over the extra points.

A recovered Humble fumble on the Wildcat 34 led to Dickinson's next touchdown. Two runs by

Simmons with a five yard penalty against Humble brought the ball to the 20. Hall then passed to Simmons to the one and Hall went over on a keeper. The extra point failed.

Humble got back into the scoring in the fourth period when Snelling passed to John Panzorel'a for a score. A pass failed for the extra points.

Dickinson scored its final marker with 15 seconds left to play when Hall passed to Lee from the Humble 17-17. A pass to end Bobby Anderson had put the ball on that spot.

Tackle Arthur Brannon and guard Kenneth Huckaby sparked the Dickinson line and fullback Dale Campbell turned in some nice gains on offense. Humble's George Goss sparked the Wildcat attack along with Snelling and Brown.
