

Gators Down Sweeny, 24-6, For Second Win of Season

SWEENY, Sept. 12 — The Dickinson High School Gators won their second victory of the season by posting a 24-6 victory over the Sweeny Bulldogs here Friday night in a high school football game.

Dickinson won its opener last week, beating Humble, 34-12.

The Gators scored at the start of the second period on a 47-yard drive. The big gainer in the

drive was a pass play from Eddie Hall to Kenneth Lee. The play

covered from the Sweeny 47 down to the five.

An offside penalty set Sweeny back to the one. Two plays later Hugh Simmons scored the touchdown. The Gators attempted a run for the points after touchdown, but Simmons was stopped short.

Midway in the same period the Gators struck paydirt on a 36-yard drive in five plays. Dale Campbell scored the touchdown from two yards out on a center plunge. An attempted pass from Hall to Lee for the extra points fell incomplete.

Dickinson struck again in the third quarter when John Cheshire blocked Lyndon Creel's punt. Ronnie Clark recovered for the Gators on the Bulldog 38-yard line.

Seven plays later the Gators scored. Campbell added the clincher from a yard out. Lee's attempted kick for the conversion was wide of the uprights.

The Gators kicked off to Sweeny, and an exchange of fumbles gave the Gators the ball on the Sweeny 21. The Gators lost seven yards on the first play, but on the following play Simmons circled left end for 18 yards down to the 10. Two plays later Hall went around left end for eight yards and the touchdown. Lee's kick for the extra point was wide.

Sweeny scored early in the last period after a penalty moved the ball to the Dickinson 19. John Lindsey passed to Thirl Autry down on the two. Two plays later Ronnie Harp went over. The kick for the extra point was wide.
