

Dickinson Gators Overpower La Porte Bulldogs, 42 to 8, 5

DICKINSON, Oct. 3 — The Dickinson Gators showed awesome power in swamping the La Porte Bulldogs, 42-8, in a district 25AA football opener for both teams here Friday night.

Dickinson, sporting a 4-1 record for the season, ballhawked La

Porte fumbles and scored a total of 24 points in the first five minutes of play.

La Porte fumbled the opening kickoff and Neil Hoak recovered for the Gators on the Bulldog 31. Seven plays later Dale Campbell carried over from the five. Eddie

Hall added the two points after the touchdown on an end sweep.

Dickinson kicked off and La Porte fumbled on the first play. Neal Fuqua recovering on the Bulldog 20. On the next play Hall passed to Kenneth Lee in the end zone for the touchdown. Hugh

Simmons powered over the extra points.

Just a minute later Hall recovered a La Porte fumble on the Bulldog 38. Seven plays later Hall scored from the nine-yard line. Lee carried over the extra points to give the Gators a 24-0 advantage in the opening five minutes of play.

In the second period, the Gators drove 37 yards in five plays to score again. The clincher came on a 30 - yard pass play from Hall to Simmons. Campbell attempted to run over the extra points, but was stopped short.

La Porte then scored its lone touchdown. It came in nine plays on a 58-yard drive. John Sauter went over from the one. Then Richard Livingston passed to Robert Olstead for the extra points.

Just before the half ended, Hall hit Lee on a screen pass that was good for 39 yards. Campbell was stopped short on trying to run over the extra points.

The final Dickinson touchdown came in the last period and was set up by a blocked kick on the Bulldog 28. It took the Gators five plays to make the touchdown with Simmons diving over from the two. An attempted pass for the extra points fell incomplete.

Lee sparked the Gator offense. He gained 90 yards in eight carries, and then picked up an additional 49 yards on passes.
