

# Gators Romp Over Santa Fe; 52-0 46

ALTA LOMA, Oct. 10 — Dickinson's Gators rolled up 385 yards rushing and scored in every period here Friday night to maul the Santa Fe Indians, 52-0 in a District 25AA football contest.

Kenneth Huckabee gobbled up three fumbles for the Gators to help set up a couple of touchdowns.

He got the first one on the

Indian 25 and later on the seventh play Eddie Hall scored from the one. Hugh Simmons ran over the extra points.

Hall later pitched out to Kenneth Lee and Lee went 65 yards for a touchdown but the extra point failed. Huckabee grabbed another fumble on the Santa Fe 31 and Hall went the 31 yards on the next play to score.

Lee scored early in the second period from the 11 on an off-

tackle play and then Dewey Sharp scored from five yards out just before the half. Dickinson tried passes on most of their extra points but missed nearly all of them.

Robert Topfer went nine yards for a third quarter Gator score and Joe Little ran four yards off tackle for one near the end of the same period. Topfer had intercepted a Santa Fe pass and carried the ball to the Indians' four to set up the score. Little also caught a pass for the extra points.

Sharp went five yards through the left side for the final Gator tally. Santa Fe's Ameal Mentzel went 65 yards in the third period for a touchdown but it was called back.
