

# Dickinson Ends Season With 26-14 Win Over Channelview

CHANNELVIEW, Nov. 7 —The Dickinson Gators closed out their 1958 football campaign with a 26-14 victory over the Channelview Falcons in a District 25AA game played here Friday night.

The win gives the Gators a 7-3 record for the season and 4-2 in the district.

The Gators scored at the start of the second period on a 54-yard drive capped off by a two-yard

plunge by Dale Campbell. Campbell also ran over the conversion to give the Gators an 8-0 lead.

Dickinson added another touchdown in the same period just 19 seconds shy of halftime. Eddie Hall passed to Kenny Lee. The pass covered 35 yards, Lee gathering it in on the 30 and racing the remaining distance for the score.

Hall's pass for the conversion

failed and Dickinson commanded 14-0 at the half.

The Gators scored in the third period on a 52-yard drive. The touchdown came when Lee plunged over from the two-yard line. Again a Hall pass for the conversion dropped incomplete.

Dickinson's last score came early in the final quarter. The Gators powered 67 yards with Lee
