

# Gators Edge Dayton, 7-0

DICKINSON — the Dickinson Gators snapped a three-game losing streak and stopped the Dayton Broncos, 7-0, here Friday night in a non-district contest.

After being pushed around by three tough foes, the Gators found a winning combination —

the Lee boys. Johnny and Danny Lee whipped up enough running power to give their team a touchdown in the opening period and then held onto for dear life the rest of the evening.

Dickinson kicked off to Dayton and the visitors fumbled on their 15, Ronald Hudson recovered for the Gators. Four plays later the Gators hit the cash register for a 7-0 lead.

Sonny Heckendorn gained

four yards and Johnnie Lee added three more yards to put the ball on Dayton's eight. Then a pass from Lee to Chuck Mills for a TD was nullified as the result of an illegal receiver downfield. The penalty put the ball back on the 21.

Danny Lee on an end sweep picked up 11 yards. Then he ran the other 10 yards around his left end for the tally. Larry Hahn kicked the extra point.

The Gators got another drive started in the same period and reached the Dayton's 19 but failed to score. In the third period the Gators recovered a fumble on the 32 and marched to the visitors' seven but lost the ball on downs.

The Broncos had one real strong threat in the final period but Heckendorn stopped this threat with a pass interception on Gator 15 and returned to the midfield stripe.

Dean Smith, Chuck Mills and Sonny Heckendorn were stand-outs on defense. Heckendorn was the top ground gainer for the Gators on offense with 91 yards in 20 carries.
