

# La Porte Swamps Gators

LA PORTE — The La Porte Bulldogs found the Dickinson Gators much to their liking and the hometowners walloped the visitors, 2-0, in a district 12AAA contest here Friday night.

After a scoreless first period

the Bulldogs found the soft spots in the Gators' defense and they quickly scored 26 points. They added seven more in the third period and 19 points in the final period.

Flu Reyes was the highest menace to the Gators with his 21 points. Reyes scored three

touchdowns and kicked three extra points.

Wayne Davis plunged three yards for the first tally and Reyes kicked his first extra point early in the second period. Later Reyes ran from the 1-yard for a tally but missed the extra point.

Midways the same period Jim Wheeler intercepted a pass and raced 53 yards for another

TD. Then a few seconds later Reyes ran over from the 1-yard for six more points.

Seven points was made in the third period when Bob Hayes scored on a 29-pass play and Reyes kicked the extra point.

In the final period Bill Green bucked over from the one yard stripe for the tally and later both Reyes and Hayes each scored touchdowns. Reyes made the extra point good with his last kick of the evening.

Dickinson's only big threat came in the third period when they reached La Porte's 34 but a pass interception stopped the drive. Dean Smith, Chuck Mills and J. J. Ali were the outstanding players for the Gators.
