

# Dickinson Skips Past Alvin, 7-6

Dickson—A Jim Stewart placement following a touchdown by halfback Selden Malin gave the Dickinson Gators a 7-6 victory over the Alvin Yellowjackets here Friday night.

The win pushed the Gators record in District 12-AAA to three wins without a loss. They meet Clear Creek next week in the district showdown.

Malin, who chalked up his eighth consecutive game as the leading ground-gainer, scored from three yards out to cap a 16-play, 65-yard drive.

The score came with 39 seconds left in the first quarter.

second period, Alvin covered 60 yards in nine plays to score, with sophomore quarterback Jim Keithly passing seven yards to halfback Steve Green for the touchdown.

Then Don Methvin dropped back to pass in a go-for-broke effort to gain the lead. But Gator defensive halfback Leroy Barrow intercepted Methvin's pass.

The Gators drove to the Alvin 13 and 15 in the first period only to see their attack sputter and die on both occasions.
