Coach Bob Mathis will instruct the offensive ends, the wingbacks, the defensive guards and the linebackers.

Coach Doug Reid is in charge of the offensive running backs and the defensive secondary.

Two new coaches are handling the Dickinson Junior Varsity this year. They are Jack Harris and Mack Dickey.

Jack Wyatt and Lorenzo Butler are the Freshman coaches for the 1968 campaign, while 8th Grade coaches Donald Lemon and John Barber and 7th Grade coaches Bogart and Jack Poole round out the Dickinson staff.
