Although some Gator fans may be taking the Dickinson-Boling scrimmage lightly, coach Ford expressed concern about the Boling club, "They've got 8 offensive and 6 defensive starters back from last year, and they are big, at least bigger than we are.

"The quarterback, who is the coach's son, throws the ball real well, and we've been told that this is the best team they've had in a long time,"

As if Ford didn't have enough problems with Boling, a guard and a tackle, who were scheduled to start this year for the Gators, appear to be out for the season.

having problems with a knee
that he injured last season and
will be out "indefinitely."
John Pawlik, 185-starting
tackle from last year, will not
suit up at all this year in all
probability due to a concussion
he received in an accident
prior to the start of fall drills.

The loss of these two boys

trims the Gator roster to thirty-five, although Barajaz may be able to see some duty later in the season.
