

THREE SENIORS PLUS TWO—This week's Senior Spot-Light focuses on three Dickinson seniors plus a pair of juniors, John Palmer and Joey Altemore, the latter scoring Dickinson's lone touchdown against Clear Creek last week. Left to right are Carl Woods, Marcus Martinez, John Palmer, Bobby Pawlik, and Joey Altemore. Woods (#24) is 5'9", 165-pound tailback-defensive back; last year, Woods carried the ball 12 times for 48 yards and one touchdown; he also returned 2 kick-offs for 23 yards and 5 punts for 38 yards. Martinez (#22) is 5'7", 150-pound defensive back; in 1967, Martinez was the Gators' second leading punt returner with 66 yards on 4 returns; starting at the defensive halfback spot this season, Martinez made 7 tackles against Angleton and four in the Clear Creek game. Palmer (#23) is 5'7", 150-pound defensive back; unlike Woods and Martinez who both lettered last year, Palmer is up from the Gators' Junior Varsity squad and has earned a starting berth in Dickinson's defensive secondary; against Angleton, Palmer intercepted one pass and returned 2 punts for 28 yards. Pawlik, the Gators' normal starting tailback, failed to see any action against Clear Creek last week due to a injury received in practice earlier in the week. Against Angleton the week before, Pawlik gained 131 yards on 19 carries and the 170-pound letterman also tallied on a 19 yard run. Altemore is 6'1", 175-pound junior who played on the Gator Junior Varsity last year. Seeing limited service against Clear Creek in the final half last week, Altemore was the Gators' leading rusher with 74 yards on 6 carries that included a 57-yard scoring run.
