

Gators Face Clear Creek Friday Nite

DICKINSON — Coach Bill Ford's Dickinson Gators journey to League City this Friday night to face coach Paul Gips' Clear Creek Wildcats this Friday night at 8 p.m.

Fans are advised to leave home well before the game time because an over-flow crowd is anticipated.

Both teams are 1-0 on the season. Dickinson edged Angleton, 12-7, and the Creek bombed La Parte, 35-8, last week.
