

Gators Play Sweeny Friday Night

DICKINSON— Attempting to avenge a 25-0 loss to Sweeny last year, Dickinson travels to Sweeny this Friday night to take on the Bulldogs at 8 p.m.

Last year's contest was one of the poorer over-all games for Dickinson last season as the Gators were shut-out, picked up only 5 first downs, gained only 65 yards rushing, and totaled only 15 yards in the air.

The Gators will also be trying to bounce back from a 28-7 defeat at the hands of

Clear Creek last week.

Against the Creek last week, the Gator defense was paced by line-backer Robert Gerasimowicz who was in on 16 tackles and by defensive end Mark Lussier who had 11.

Linebacker Dennis Cooke, defensive end Lewis Little, and safety Bobby Thompson were next with 7 tackles each. Ted Roeser, Ronald Thomas, Randy Battistoni and Allen Welch had six each.

The probable Dickinson offensive starting line-up: Ends Lewis Little (185) and Al Moffett (180); tackles Tommy Godard (190) and Clarence Hall (180); guards Allen Welch (165) and Tommy Cooper (175); center Robert Gerawimowicz (220); quarterback Raymond Young (155); tailback Bobby Pawlik (170); wingback Dennis

Cooke (150); and fullback Edward Shavers (205).

The probable Dickinson defensive starting line-up: Ends Mark Lussier (175) and Mike Mills (170); tackles Godard and Ronald Thomas (185); line-backers Welch, Gerasimowicz and Cooke; halfback Marcus Martinez (155) and John Palmer (150); and safeties Ted Roeser (160) and Bobby Thompson (170).

GATOR TALES DEPT.— The Gators don't face the Alvin Yellowjackets until October 11, but Alvin scouts have been quite prevelant at the past two Dickinson games and at the Dickinson scrimmages. The Dickinson-Alvin game is the first District 12-AAA game for both teams and most observers feel the loop title will be decided by the contest.
