



**FOUR DICKINSON LINEMEN**—This week's Dickinson Gator spot-light focuses on four Dickinson players who provide the blocking for the Dickinson backs. Front row left to right: guard Leonard Barajaz and tackle Clarence Hall. Back row left to right: tackle Lee Roy Campbell and tackle Tommy Godard. Barajaz is a 5'10", 175-pound junior letterman; he was out most of last season with a knee injury, but has returned in good shape this year; he handles the Gator PAT work and is one for one in that department this year; last week, Barajaz alternated with Allan Welch at the guard spot. Hall is a 6', 184-pound junior who starts at one of the tackle slots for the Gators; seeing double-duty on both offense and defense, Hall accounted for 7 tackles in his best defensive performance this year. Campbell (#74) is a 6', 180-pound senior who is one of the key members of the Gators' kick-off and punting teams; against Sweeny last week, Campbell helped limit the Bulldogs' return yardage with three tackles. Godard (#75) is a 6'3", 195-pound senior letterman; Godard is a two-way starter for Dickinson as an offensive and a defensive tackle; Godard had two of his better games this year against Angleton and Sweeny on defense with 8 tackles in each of those games.
