As for the Gators, the team has been placed on the contenders' list. The special prize is center - linebacker Robert Gerasimowicz (6-2, 226) a lineman of tremendous ability. End Lewis Little and tackle Tommy Godard are also dandies.

Quarterback Raymond Young and HB Bobby Pawlik are combat - tested backs and they'll compete against the passing and running combination of Alvin's QB Gary Keithley to SPE Robert Cain along with power runners David Adams and fullback Tommy Wollam.

The biggest problem for the Gators on Friday night will be finding a way to keep Keithley bottled up and this will stop the smooth - running offensive machine of the Yellow Jackets.

Keithley was all - district in 1966-67 and a collector of 1,324 yards in total offense a year ago and HB David Adams a '67 all - league choice gained 1,137 total offense.

Ford's fighting Gators are the underdog here Friday night but their all-out determination could mean a lot in this contest.
