

Alvin Outscores Dickinson 34-23

DICKINSON—Alvin, the states No. 2 team in class AAA, ripped the Dickinson Gators 34-23 here Friday night to score a 34-23 victory in the start of District 12-AAA warfare.

A crowd of approximately 6,500 saw Alvin, unbeaten in five tries, get a quick lead when David Harris scored on a 36 yard run. Jim Stevens added the conversion.

Alvin opened the gap in the second period when Tom Wollam went over from the three to cap a 62-yard drive. This time David Adams added the conversion.

A Gator fumble set up Alvin's next score from 15 yards out, and when the halftime intermission came the Yellow Jackets owned a 21-0 lead.

Dickinson got into the game in the third period on a 67 yard drive that was capped by Raymond Young's 27 yard pass to Dennis Cook. Leonard Barajau converted.

Alvin struck right back on a 55-yard march with Gary Keithley going the final three yards. Stevens converted.

The Gators bounced right back with a young to Lewis Little pass

good for 63 yards and a touchdown in the final period. Young passed to Carwyn Abraham for the two extra points.

But Alvin wasn't through yet. Harris drove the final six yards to cap an 80-yard drive as the Jackets upped the lead to 34-15.

Young was the leading passer for the night for Alvin with 15 completions in 25 tries for 296 yards.

Robert Gerasimowicz was Dickinson's top defensive player with 12 tackles.
