

Gerasimowicz Named To All-State Offensive Team

DICKINSON-Dickinson High School joined the top twenty in high school football when Robert Gerasimowicz was named center to the offensive team, in 3A All-State nominations.

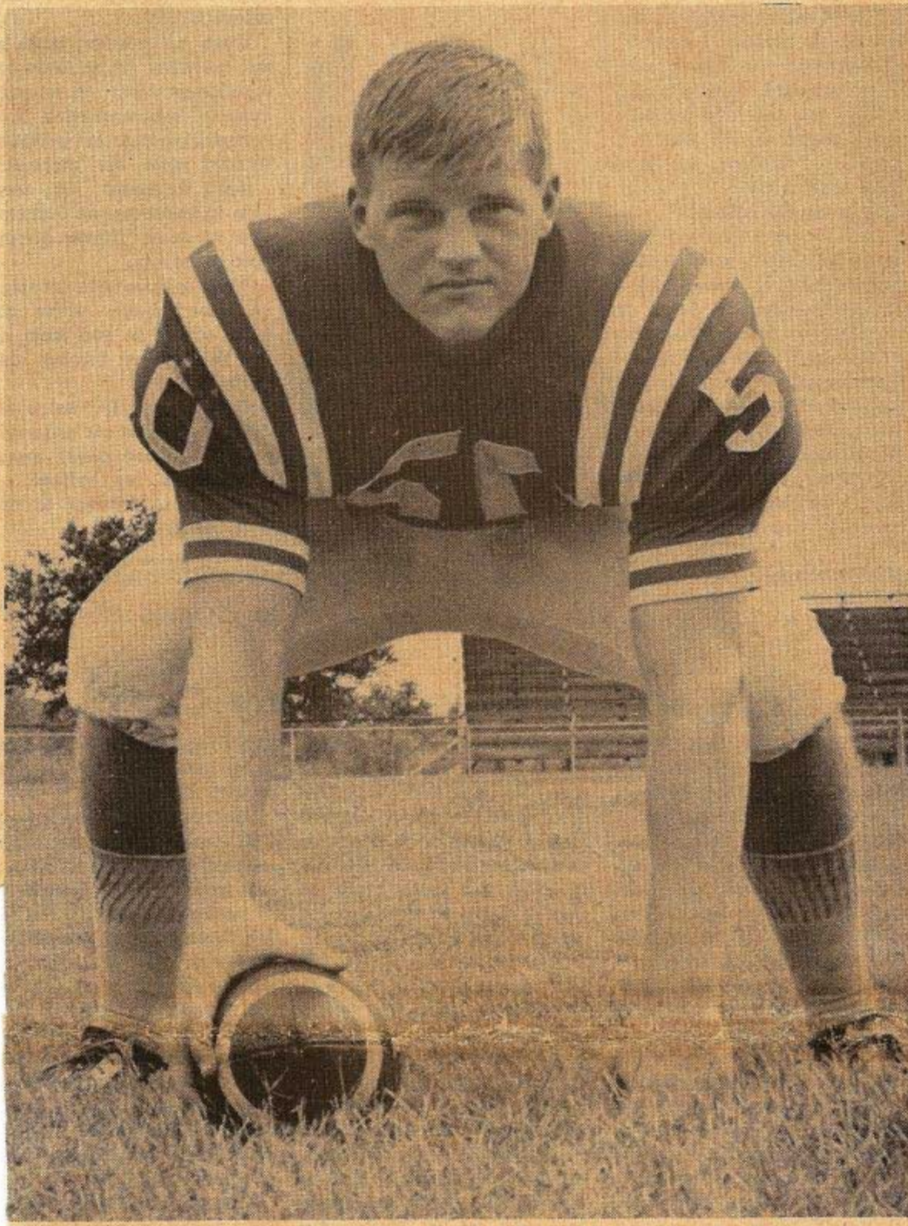
Gerasimowicz, a 6 foot 2 inch tall senior was joined in the list by quarterback Gary Keithly of Alvin High School.

Also named from Alvin was tackle Larry Peterson, a senior, who was picked for the defensive eleven. Lewis Little, an end from Dickinson High was given an honorable mention on offense.

In the 1968 All District 12-AAA selections Lewis Little, end was named; Tommy Cooper, a guard was named to second place and Gerasimowicz named as center, all to the offensive team.

Bobby Pawlik was named as third place running back on the offensive team. On the defensive team, Tommy Godard of Dickinson was given third place as a down lineman and Robert Gerasimowicz named linebacker in the second slot.

Gerasimowicz was also named as most valuable lineman on the all-district team.



DICKINSON ALL-STATERS — Dickinson Gator center Robert Gerasimowicz was named to the Ft. Worth Star-Telegram's 1st team at the offensive center spot on its Class AAA All-State team last week. Dickinson end Lewis Little was chosen to the Honorable Mention squad. Gerasimowicz was a 3-year letterman. In 1966, he intercepted one pass and recovered one fumble in the end zone; in 1967, he picked off a pair of passes and also recovered one loose ball; last season, he intercepted one pass and recovered one fumble. Little was also a 3-year letter-winner; he grabbed 13 passes for 228 yards and one TD in 1966; in 1967, Little caught 15 passes for 258 yards and 7 touchdowns; and in 1968, Little received 34 passes for 538 yards and 4 touchdowns. "Ger" stands 6'2" and weighs 220 pounds, while Lewis is 6'3" and weighs 184 pounds.
