8th Grade Track Scoops Pearland

Coach Terry Vestal's Dickinson McAdams Jr. High School 8th Grade Track Team brought home the team championship trophy when they traveled to Alvin on March 7, when they edged Pearland by a 140-138 margin for first place.

In the shot put, Scott Bond placed third with a distance of 43'9" and Tim Hopf was fourth with a distance of 42'1/2" to add four more points.

Wallace Hogan placed third in the discus with a distance of 121'8" for six points and Tim Anderson added two more with a fifth place with an effort of 115'0".

Darrel Rollins gathered in 10 points for Dickins a with a first place finish in 12 long jump when he got out to 16'5" and David DeLa Rosa was a close second with 16'1" for eight more points. Billy Jones pulled in an additional point for the Gators with a sixth place finish in the high jump when he cleared 5'0".

In the two mile relay, Warren Crockett, Craig White, Bruce Brunner, and Thomas O'Neal teamed to take third place with a time of 9:23.7 to add 12 more points.

Billy Jones hit a good time of 10.8 seconds to finish third in the 70 yard intermediate hurdles.

Dickinson added 20 big points when they took first place in the 440 yard relay with a time of 47.7 seconds. The relay team was composed of Tim Anderson, Dennis Jenkins, David DeLa Rose, and Darrel Rollins.

The Gators placed two men in the scoring column for the 100 yard dash; with Darrel Rollins placing second with a time of 11.2 seconds and Tim Anderson in sixth place at 11.6 seconds...

In was a two-man finish for the Gators in the 440 yard dash, also. Warren Crockett took second place with a time of 57.8 seconds and David DeLaRosa placed sixth at 58.9.

The Gators were 1-3-4 in the 250 yard low hurdles as Billy Jones got the first place blue ribbon with a time of 31.5 seconds: Dennis Jenkins was third at 32.3; and Steve Barkman placed fourth with a time of 32.4 seconds.

Darrell Rollins took first place in the 220 yard dash with an excellent time of 25.1 seconds and Tim Anderson added two more points with a 25.8 effort which earned him fifth place.

In the final event of the day, the mile relay, the Gator foursome of Steve Barkman, George Mason, David DelaRose, and Dennis Jenkins teamed to hit 3:54.6 and take second place and earn 16 points.

For the meet, Darrell Rollins was high point man for the Gators with 33 points.
