Each ex-student has replied to the invitations, and I believe we will have all of them in Dickinson by May 29. Hotel accommodations were available at the Hotel Baker.

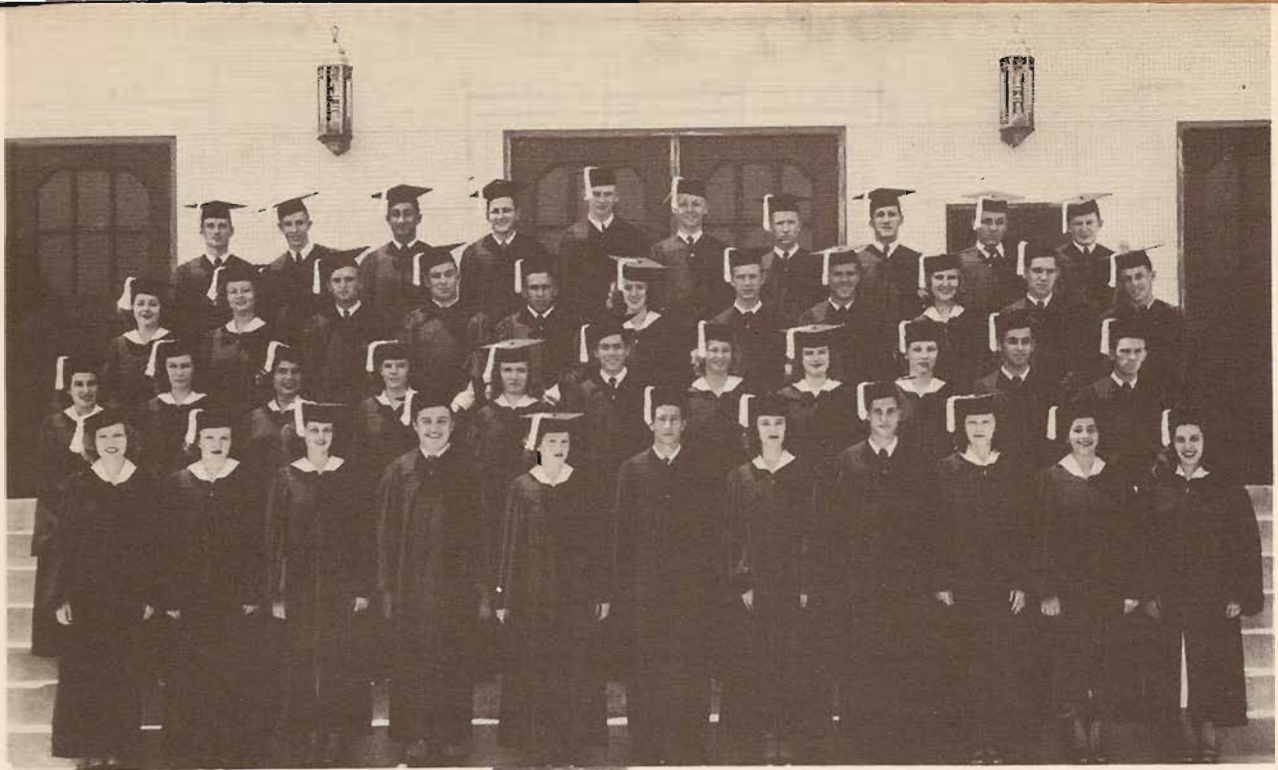
The completed plans for the three days are shown on the enclosed program.

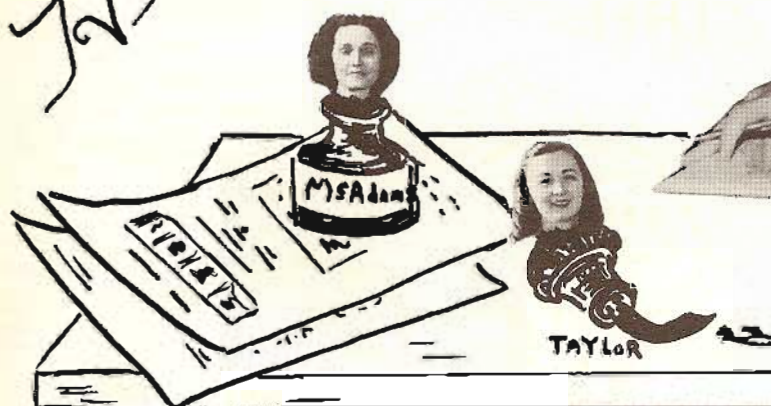
