Martin 'Shug' Risinger is president of the Mineral Oil, Inc. of Boston, Massachusetts.


Stephen Martelli, with his excellent training as president of the Senior class, has gone on to greater things. He is now the mayor and leading citizen of Dickinson.

Each ex-student has replied to the invitations, and I believe we will have all of them in Dickinson by May 29. Hotel accommodations were available at the Hotel Baker.




