## MR. O.J. BAKER

### Superintendent of Schools

Superintendent O. J. Baker was born in Baylor County, Texas in 1912, and attended Sam Houston State Teachers College, where he served as president of the Student Council during his senior year and was sports editor of the college paper for two years.

Graduating from Sam Houston in 1933, Baker accepted a teaching position in Dickinson in the commercial department, and also took up duties as a coach. He became principal of the Dickinson system in 1935 and principal of Dickinson High School in 1939 as the system grew. In the meantime, he attended the University of Texas in the summers and received his Master's Degree there in 1939.

He joined the military service in 1942 and served four years with the Field Artillery in North Africa and Italy, receiving the Legion of Merit as a non-commissioned officer. He entered the service as a private and worked up with a battlefield promotion to the rank of a commissioned officer.

In 1946 he returned to Dickinson as Superintendent of Schools, after having served for a brief time as one of the organizers and teachers for the University of Florence, the first overseas university set up by the armed forces.

As an educator, Baker has served as a member of the State Textbook Committee, and is now serving as a member of the State Legislative Council for the University Interscholastic League Activities. He is also serving as chairman of the State Curriculum Commission for the study of Business Education. He served as president of the Gulf Coast Research Development Association for the school year 1957-58 and is at present a member of the Board of Directors of the Association.

Superintendent Baker was elected as the Man of the Year by the Senior Chamber of Commerce for 1957 and is now a member of the Board of Directors of the Bay Area Boy Scouts of America and the Anti-T. B. Association.

We are fortunate in having a man with such varied talents and experiences as the Superintendent of our school system.



## MR. R.D. McADAMS

### Principal

Mr. Robert D. McAdams was born in Midway, Texas, October 27, 1921. He graduated from high school in 1939 and received his Bachelor of Science Degree from Sam Houston State Teachers College in 1942. The Master of Education Degree was granted him in 1950 by the University of Houston.

In 1942, Mr. McAdams came to Dickinson as an industrial arts teacher. He was elected Principal of the High School in 1952.

Through the years Mr. McAdams has become very interested in guns--from hunting with them to making them. He is a member of the National Rifle Association.

The community has profited by having a man of such caliber in her schools. He has been President of the local Lions Club, President of the Local Texas State Teachers Association, Transportation Director for local Civil Defense, Director of the Galveston County Lighthouse for the Blind, Reporting member to *Gusreda*, an educational publication, and has been listed in *Who's Who in Education in the South and Southwest*.

Mr. McAdams is always gracious and helpful in counseling with students when they have problems in schedules, personal matters, and making plans for the future. We are indeed fortunate in having him as our Principal.
